Hello friends. Well it's been a busy January for us, shifting from the farm after nearly 40 years there and into our new home at 387A Te Moana Road in Waikanae. Forty years of clutter took quite some clearing out, especially the three garages, but we did it. We are loving our new home and look forward to hosting Friendship Force gatherings in our lovely new garden.

As you know I have now relinquished my role as RSM and handed over to Liv Goudie in Whangaparoa. Liv is looking forward to attending the National Gathering in April where you can meet her – more about that shortly.

I am looking forward to leading the *Great Cycle Trails of New Zealand* ebike tour arriving in Auckland on the 10<sup>th</sup>. We are a group of 20 keen ebikers, with the 19 others from the USA and Canada, and all aged between 60-72. We will be arriving in Kapiti for our week's hosting on February 19<sup>th</sup>, with half the group being hosted here and the other half being hosted by the Wellington FF Club. Other than Don & Judy Keats, who also have ebikes, the rest of the hosts for this group have been recruited from our Kapiti ebike group, as I felt it was important that the hosts cycle with their guests. Hopefully we'll recruit a couple of new FF members from the biking hosts! The tour includes a week with the Hamilton-Waikato Club biking the trails there, and touring the South Island including riding the Lake Dunstan and Otago Rail Trails.

There will be an opportunity for you to meet our biking ambassadors on our non-biking day, which is Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> February. We will be picnicking and playing games at the Otaihanga Domain from 1pm on that day, and we'd love you to join us so our guests – and our new hosts – can meet some of our club members. It's a BYO picnic, and if the weather is not conducive to outdoor dining we'll meet instead at Big Mac's Slabs where we can picnic undercover. Do put that date in your diary and come along to share in the fun.

You will have received information in the last few days about the 2024 National Gathering, to be held at Silverstream Retreat in Upper Hutt. Wellington FF club is organising this event which will take place from Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> to Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> April, with most of the activities taking place on Friday 5<sup>th</sup>. Please do consider coming to Silverstream – it's a great opportunity to meet up with old friends and make new ones, and the accommodation is great. You can also take part in discussions on the Friday about the future focus for FFI and hear new ideas for growing and strengthening our clubs. We also have great entertainment planned for the Friday night. Day registration just for the Friday is available for the registration fee of \$140, as most of the expenses are incurred on that day. **As we have done for previous Gatherings, your club is happy to subsidise the cost of registration to the tune of \$50 per member.** We need 50 registrants to break even, so do support your organisation and come to Silverstream for the Gathering.

After the Gathering is over we are offering a weekend of hosting by Wairarapa, Wellington and Kapiti Coast clubs. If you would like to host some of your FF friends for two nights (Saturday and Sunday) please let me know.

Meantime enjoy the summer weather – it's certainly been changeable, but hopefully things will settle down now.

Margaret, together with Leicester, was such a wonderful club member and ambassador and we have enjoyed travelling with them, hearing of their adventures and sharing their hospitality at home and at their daughter's home.

Margaret made a great contribution to the club with her outstanding leadership as President in 2004, 2005 and 2006 during a very active time.

She was a coordinator for inward journeys in 1991 (Omaha, Nebraska), 1995 (Hamburg, Germany), 1999 (Tucson, Arizona), 2007 (North Bay, Canada), and domestic journeys from Western Waikato, Manawatu and Wairarapa.

Leicester was coordinator for an outward journey in 1993 to Changmai, Thailand and Margaret led journeys 2000 (Glasshouse Mountains and Newcastle, Australia), and in 2004, a domestic journey to Wanganui.

They virtually always hosted and together went on many journeys or exchanges.

One of the club's legends is the story of Margaret's training routine in 1999 at Jim Cooke Park in preparation for the Japanese squat toilets, sadly not completely successful, but a great story!

Margaret was a wonderful supporter of our club over many years and will be fondly remembered and sadly missed.
